Many thanks to those of you who came into school for the recent Parents' Evening; it is always good to meet with parents and exchange information about our pupils.



The CCG hope that this website will mean that children, young people and their families are able to get help when they need it and also do things to make themselves stronger, so they are more able to cope when things are tough.



Pupil Illness and Absence

Please let us know as soon as possible if your child is off school sick by contacting us on 01452 874000.

If your child catches a cold or infection, please keep him or her off school to avoid the infection spreading to other children (and staff) in the class.

This is especially important when a child has a tummy bug such as vomiting or diarrhoea. In this case, children should be clear of symptoms for <u>48</u> hours before they return to school. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

If you plan to take your child out of school in term time please ask your child's class teacher for a permission form or you can download it from the school website.

This form should be completed and sent into school giving as much notice as you can. Lyn Dance, Headteacher will provide a written response to all requests.
