

Year 7 Catch Up Premium

The government has provided additional funding to support those pupils in Year 7 who are below Level 4 in either English and/or maths. At The Milestone School, this funding applies to all Year 7 pupils.

In 2015-16, the school received £12,500 in Year 7 Catch Up Premium, which was spent on:

- A teacher who taught small group sessions for one day a week.
- Two teachers to teach weekly 1:1 sessions.
- A G grade LSW to deliver weekly Sensory Groups to enhance learning.
- Two iPads and 10 Laptops to support pupil learning.
- Maths Resources.

Last year the impact of this funding enabled Year 7 pupils to make the following progress:

- 80% of pupils made small steps of progress over one year in English.
- 84% of pupils made small steps of progress over one year in maths.

In 2016-17, the school received £15,000 in Year 7 Catch Up Premium, which will be spent on:

- Purchasing equipment and resources that will directly support the Year 7 pupils to effectively access the curriculum and make progress within it i.e. Sensory resources for pupils with Profound and Multiple Learning Difficulties and Complex Needs, Laptops to support a pupil to effectively access and complete learning tasks and activities etc.
- Purchasing pupil led technology, e.g. LearnPads, which would enable them to learn and progress at their own pace and feel confident they are achieving and succeeding in maths and English.
